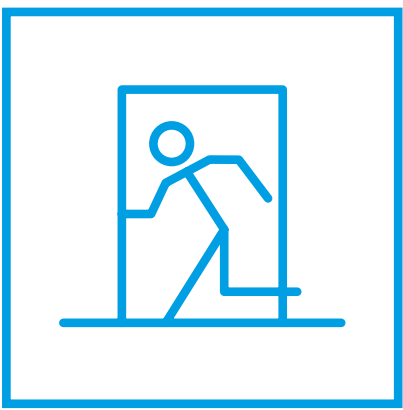
## MOST IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS



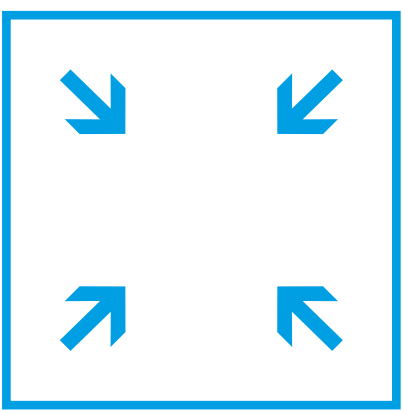
In any case, please follow the instructions of your contact person.



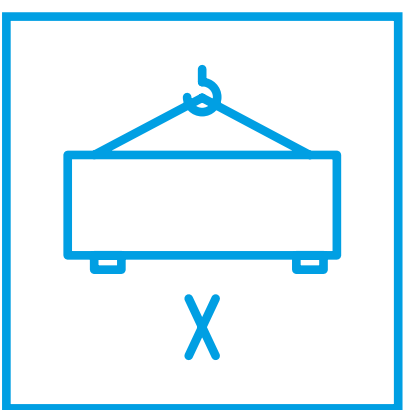
Watch out for industrial trucks and casting ladles and use the marked walkways.



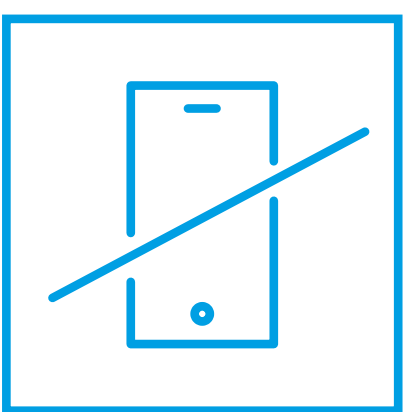
Escape routes are marked appropriately.



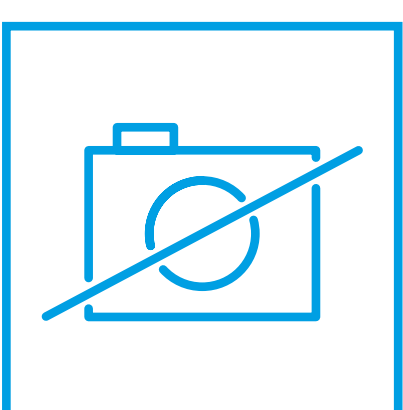
Should the area you are visiting need to be evacuated please proceed to the rescue point assigned to you. The announcement will be made via loudspeaker.

Hearing protection

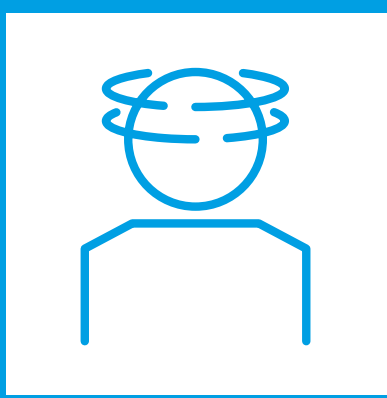


Safety goggles
